Background	resp pho: triph PLC subf Pho Seri this noni PLC	Phosphoinositide-specific phospholipase C (PLC) plays a significant role in transmembrane signaling. In response to extracellular stimuli such as hormones, growth factors and neurotransmitters, PLC hydrolyzes phosphatidylinositol 4,5-bisphosphate (PIP2) to generate two secondary messengers: inositol 1,4,5-triphosphate (IP3) and diacylglycerol (DAG) (1). At least four families of PLCs have been identified: PLC β , PLC γ , PLC γ and PLC γ . The PLC γ subfamily includes four members, PLC γ 1-4. All four members of the subfamily are activated by γ 2- or γ 3-y-subunits of the heterotrimeric G-proteins (2,3). Phosphorylation is one of the key mechanisms that regulates the activity of PLC. Phosphorylation of Ser1105 by PKA or PKC inhibits PLC γ 3 activity (4,5). Ser537 of PLC γ 3 is phosphorylated by CaMKII, and this phosphorylation may contribute to the basal activity of PLC γ 3. PLC γ 4 is activated by both receptor and nonreceptor tyrosine kinases (6). PLC γ 4 forms a complex with EGF and PDGF receptors, which leads to the phosphorylation of PLC γ 4 at Tyr771, 783 and 1248 (7). Phosphorylation by Syk at Tyr783 activates the enzymatic activity of PLC γ 1 (8).
