SMC1 Antibody detects endogenous levels of total SMC1 protein.

Source / Purification Polyclonal antibodies are produced by immunizing animals with synthetic peptides corresponding to

residues near the amino terminus of human SMC1. Antibodies are purified by protein A and peptide affinity

chromatography.

Background Structural maintenance of chromosomes 1 (SMC1) protein is a chromosomal protein member of the

cohesin complex that enables sister chromatid cohesion and plays a role in DNA repair (1,2). ATM/NBS1-dependent phosphorylation of SMC1 occurs at Ser957 and Ser966 in response to ionizing radiation (IR) as part of the intra-S-phase DNA damage checkpoint (3). SMC1 phosphorylation is ATM-independent in cells subjected to other forms of DNA damage, including UV light and hydroxyurea treatment (4). While phosphorylation of SMC1 is required for activation of the IR-induced intra-S-phase checkpoint, the precise mechanism is not well understood and may involve a conformational change that affects SMC1-SMC3

interaction (3).

Western Blot Buffer IMPORTANT: For western blots, incubate membrane with diluted primary antibody in 5% w/v BSA, 1X TBS,

0.1% Tween® 20 at 4°C with gentle shaking, overnight.
